

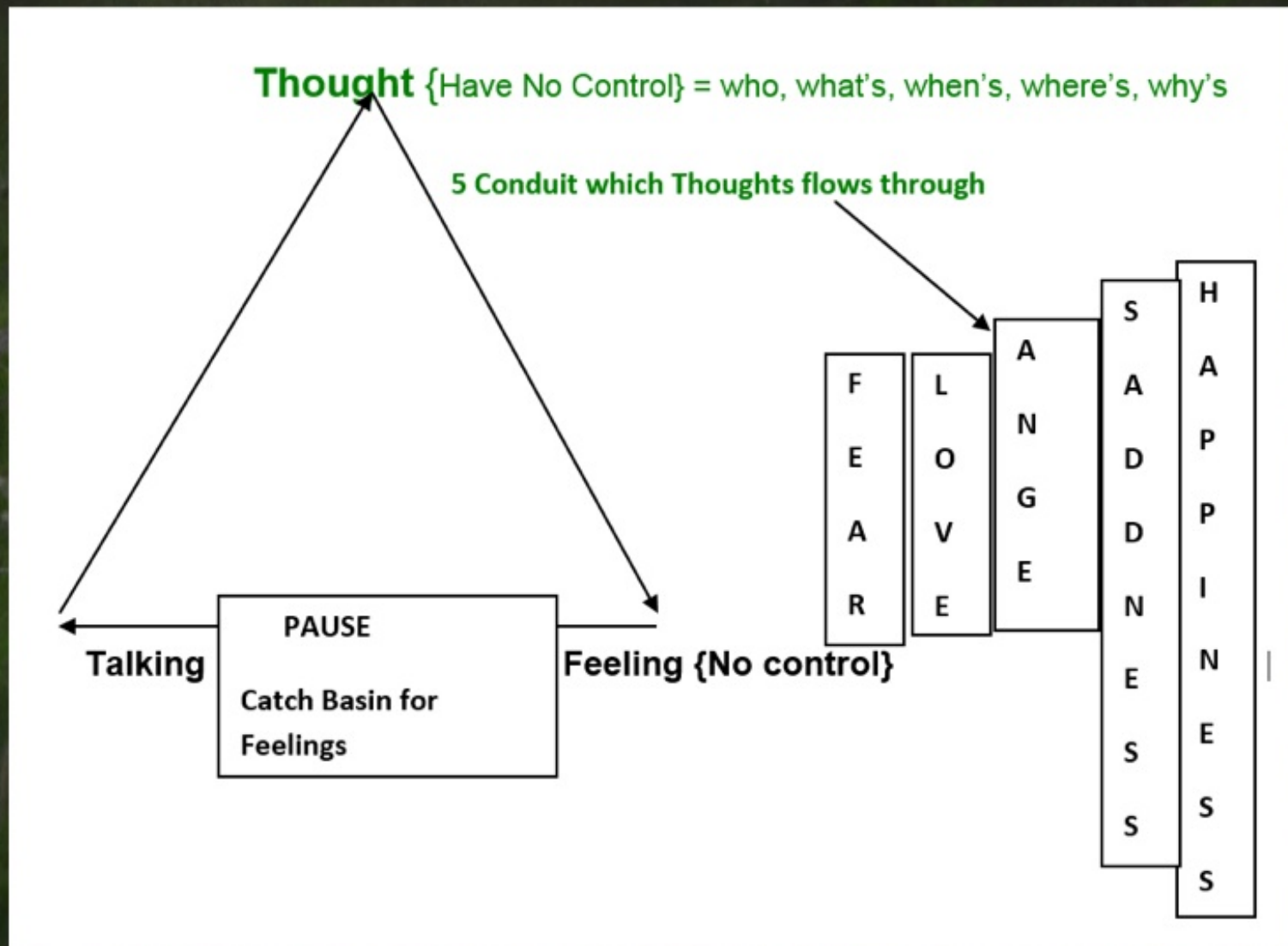

The Trinity of Life {Thought, Feeling & Talking}

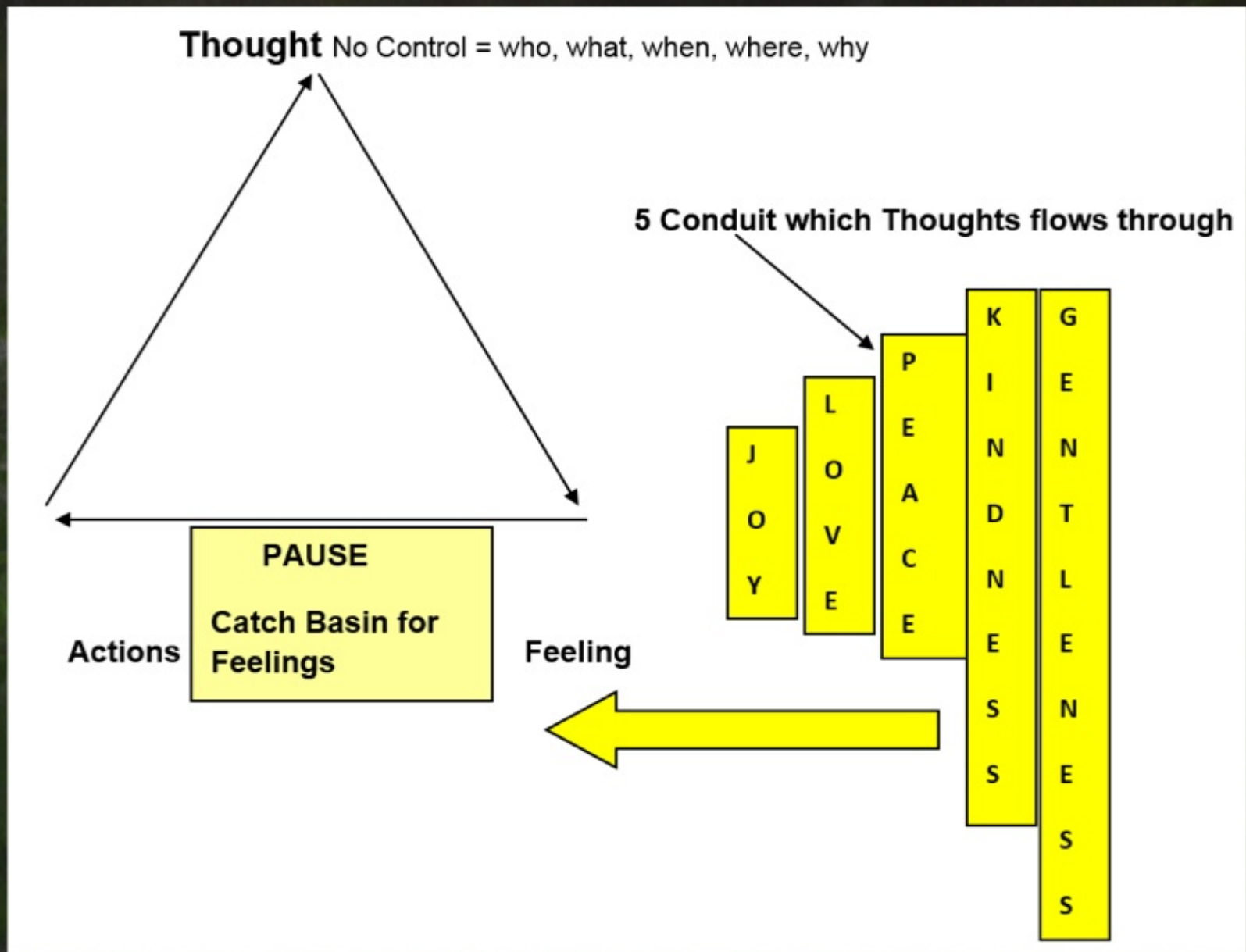


The 5 conduit filters, which your thought energy flows through

1 Timothy 6:19.....Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation **against the time to come**, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

1 Timothy 6:17-19....Tell those who have the riches of this world not to be arrogant and not to place their confidence in anything as uncertain as riches. Instead, they should place their confidence in God who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. **Tell them to do good, and by doing a lot of good things, to be generous, and to share. By Doing This, they store up a treasure for themselves** which is a good foundation for the future. In this way they take hold of what life really is.

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, (Directive)

- whatsoever things are true,

- if there be any virtue, and
- if there be any praise,

(Declarative) **THINK On these things, until these Thoughts** become your Habitual Thoughts Patterns

Against That Day....Example:..... Jesus in his temptations...

Never Doubt In Darkness, To What Was Revealed IN You AS Light...

Begin to write by journaling 100's of times what has been shown to you in your "enlighten moments"

The 3 Then's = Of Temptations

Luke 4:1-12.....Then Jesus, full of the “Enlighten Spirit’s Light”, returned from the Jordan River. Jesus was inward led by his Spirit-Thought in the wilderness, where he was tempted by the devil {Negativity} for forty days. Jesus ate nothing all that time and became very hungry

(1)-Then the **Negative Thought** made a suggestion to Jesus’ conscious **Through His Thoughts**.....“If you are the **Son of God**, why don’t you change this stone into a loaf of bread, to satisfy your own need & want {hungry}”

Noticethe first and far most temptation was this “negative thought”, is to get you to question your “True Identity” **Are You Really?**... To Question your own Authenticity **But Jesus told HIMSELF**, “**No!** The Scriptures say, ‘People do not live by bread alone.’ BUT people do live BY what they tell themselves

Gold Nugget: What you lay-up for yourself “**Against That Day**” Will Be What You’ll **GO TO** when push comes to shove.....

No-One will be able to “**Confirm for your satisfaction who you are**.... This **IS what you must “Affirm”** within your own self..... What people confirm to you will Not-last very long if you do not “Affirm It To One’s self **IT IS SO**.....

(2)- Then another **Negative Thought** carried **Jesus up within his Imagination** and revealed to him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. "I will give you the Glory of these kingdoms and authority over them," the negative thought suggested, "because they are mine to give to anyone I please. I will give it all to you if you will worship me." Jesus replied, "The Scriptures say, 'You must worship the Lord your God and serve only him.'

Notice This is exactly what Jesus's mission was, was to win the world, **this would be a "Short Cut".....** get it accomplished a much easier Way..... With this way of thinking it would "Cut-Out" all of His suffering and Yet Still accomplish His Goal, every-one would win

(3)- **Then** the devil took Jesus to Jerusalem within Jesus's Imagination, to the highest point of the Temple, and said, "If you are the Son of God, jump off! For the Scriptures say, 'He will order his angels to protect and guard you. And they will hold you up with their hand so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone.' ..."

Again Jesus had "lay up for himself **AGAINST** that day his responses, So here Jesus responded back to the negatives with his Positives, "The Scriptures also say, 'You must not test the Lord your God.'"

Luke 4:13..... When the Negative Thinking had finished tempting Jesus, the negative thoughts left him **until the next opportunity came**.....
